Follow the Girl Scout Promise and Law

Be a sister to every Girl Scout. Remember that behind every screen is a human being with independent thoughts and feelings. It is easy to misunderstand or be rude to others when you are not interacting with them in person. Before posting ask yourself: Would you say it to the person's face?

Adhere to the same standards of behavior as in "real life."

This rule is a reminder that the ethical standards and laws that govern our society extend to cyberspace as well. This includes harassment and bullying, the use of profanity, copyright regulations, and privacy.

Respect other people's time and bandwidth

In this rule, "bandwidth" is synonymous with "time." When you post on a discussion board, keep your comments brief and relevant to the environment or situation. Monopolizing and offensive commentary in Rallyhood could result in removal.

Share expert knowledge

Rallyhood is a great platform for sharing useful information. However, it can also be used to spread misinformation and distortions. If you hold a lot of knowledge about a certain topic or subject, don't be afraid to share it online in a manner that is helpful and accurate.

Be forgiving of other people's mistakes

Give other users the benefit of the doubt and consider that they may come from a different background or have less experience. Do not be rude when you encounter someone's mistake -- always respond with courtesy and respect.
